

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE

The County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, will hold a Public Hearing on the Proposed Annual Action Plan for Housing and Community Development covering Fiscal Year (FY) 2010 (July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010) and hereby solicits public comments from residents of the County.

The Annual Action Plan is an implementation strategy of the County's approved 5-year *Consolidated Plan* and responds to the priority needs of low and moderate-income residents by providing quality affordable housing, building a better living environment, and expanding economic opportunities.

The Annual Action Plan also serves as the application for Federal funding: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG), and the HOME Investment Partnership programs. The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has advised the County that formula allocations for FY 2010 have been made in the following accounts: CDBG - \$6,063,206 plus \$198,700 in Program Income; HOME - \$3,120,592 plus \$300,000 in Program Income; and ESG - \$269,322 plus \$269,322 in Matching Funds.
